This Friday is our last swimming lesson for the year. It is part of the assessment criteria/curriculum to participate in a clothed swim. We ask if you child could bring clothes that are not too heavy (no denim), something like pyjamas, to wear while swimming, over their bathers or shorts, and a bag to carry wet cloths home in. It has been very exciting to see the strength and swimming confidence, abilities improve in our students over the course of this term. The focus for our vounger students has been on water familiarisation and stroke development, whilst for our older students, as well as proper technique for regular swimming styles, students have been learning survival strokes, gliding challenges, practicing safe entries into the water. All students thoroughly enjoyed the program and to see their progression has been terrific.
